

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:



- **How can I enter the expo?**
 - 1) Be fully vaccinated, OR
 - 2) Have proof of negative covid testing
 - 3) Wear a mask
- **Who gets checked?** Venue operators must check the identification of *all attendees age 18 and over* to validate their vaccination record or proof of negative test.
- **What does "fully vaccinated" mean?** People are considered fully vaccinated for COVID-19: two weeks or more after they have received the second dose in a 2-dose series (Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna), two weeks or more after they have received a single-dose vaccine (Johnson and Johnson [J&J]/Janssen), or two weeks after receipt of another vaccine authorized by the World Health Organization (WHO).
- **What is acceptable as proof of a negative COVID-19 test result?**
 - 1) A printed document from the test provider or laboratory, OR
 - 2) An electronic test result displayed on a phone or other device from the test provider or laboratory.
The information should include person's name, type of test performed, and negative test result
- 3) Children under 2 years of age are exempt from the testing requirement
- **How long before coming can I get the test?** Testing must be conducted within *one day for an antigen test* and within *two days for a PCR test* prior to entry into an event. Results of the test must be available prior to entry into the facility.
- **Will testing be available at the expo?** Yes--but **no** rapid testing will be offered.
